- 3. <u>National Association of Broadcasters Career Fair 2021</u> to be held at the upcoming NAB Las Vegas Convention in October 2021.
- 4. <u>Internship Program</u>: CSN International offers an internship program designed to assist members of the community, mainly students from local colleges and universities, to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. Those students who are involved in the internship program

gain knowledge in the areas of news, weather, production/operations, and overall business skills, in order to get real experiences in broadcasting. Each of these student interns will be considered candidates for future job openings at CSN International.
