## PROMOTING YOUR PROGRAM

Working with many radio groups and over the course of seven years, CSN's research partner has analyzed over 4 billion **national** radio ad responses. In the “Charitable/Religious/Nonprofit” category, the optimal characteristics of a radio schedule to run spots on CSN to promote your program:

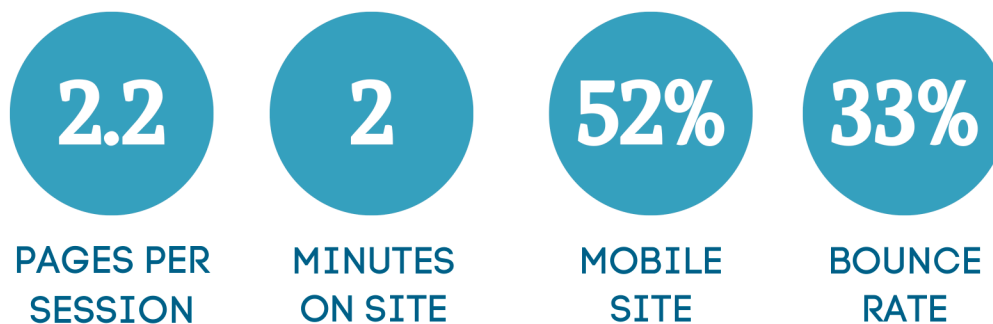
- is in **midday daypart**, from 10 AM to 3 PM (this is the top daypart with the highest response.)
- is on **Monday** (this is the day with the highest response.)
- is using **60 seconds** spots (this is the top ad duration with the highest response.)
- and each ad aired yielded an **average of three website visits**.

## DIGITAL IMPACT

Based on the average of three website visits per spot aired, web visitors:

- viewed 2.2 pages per session.
- spent 2 minutes and 7 seconds on the site.
- engaged on the site 52% of the time on a mobile device.
- had a low 33% Bounce Rate.

## STATIONS

One-quarter of our stations are East of the Mississippi, three-quarters are West of the Mississippi.

## THE IMPACT OF RADIO

Our research has shown that in the “Charitable/Religious/Nonprofit” category, advertisers on average:

- ran 264.9 spots per campaign.
- were on the air for 14.2 days.
- on hiatus (off the air) for 14.3 days
- ran 18.6 ads per day
- generated web visitors who found the advertiser’s website using a search engine on 96.5% of all visits.

We analyzed over **4 billion national** radio ad responses over seven years in the “Charitable/Religious/Nonprofit” category. Our research has shown the best practices in terms of your radio creative for an ad schedule on CSN to promote your program, would include:

- repeating your website address.
- using a female voice.
- using the words, "Today" and "Understand"

## PRODUCTION/PROMOTION SUMMARY

Based on this empirical data, the characteristics of a successful ad campaign to promote your program on CSN:

- is to make 10 AM to 3 PM the focus of your 60-second ad schedule.
- to concentrate your spots on Monday.
